General Convention Info

- For all workshops, bring basic machine sewing supplies (BSS). These basic supplies may not be listed separately in each workshop list. (see page 11 for list)
- An iron and ironing surface will be provided in each classroom. You may bring your own iron if desired but it is not necessary.
- For some workshops, instructors may make available additional items that are not included in the class fee. These items are optional and are at your discretion to purchase or not during the seminar directly from your instructor.
- Due to space limitations, please do not bring additional tables/work surfaces into the classrooms.
- Those who require seating accommodations (due to vision, hearing, or mobility) should let us know when checking in.
- Please do not "Save" tables for the next day's workshop. A designated "parking" area will be identified to leave equipment overnight if desired. The Conference Center will be locked each evening but items left in the building are your responsibility.
- There will be availability for setup of your machine in your next class at the end of each day following dinner. Please see the page 12 for more information about additional Sit & Sew opportunities.
- Due to health issues, please do not wear perfume/scents during the conference.
- The only people who may be in a classroom while a workshop is in session are those students who are enrolled in that workshop. Class Angels will be asked to assist in making sure that anyone in a classroom is on the enrollment sheet. This policy will be strictly enforced.
