Dear Quilt Instructor,

The Jabez Quilt Seminar planning committee and the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service are sponsoring JQS 2024 to be held January 16-24, 2024, at the Cave City Convention Center in Cave City, KY. The featured teacher for JQS 2024 will be Judy Gauthier. Judy is an expert at scrap quilting and helps people use odd scraps through unique cutting techniques and color placement theory. She is a fabric designer, quilt shop owner, author, and lecturer and share quilting tips and techniques at bungalowquilting.com.

The goal of the Jabez Quilt Seminar (JQS) is to provide economical educational experiences for quilters who want to learn new and innovative techniques at home, in Kentucky. We strive to provide a variety of techniques and teachers during the conference. Classes will be offered in half-day and full-day workshops, and we would like to offer a variety of classes including quilts, home décor quilted items and wearables.

Teaching fees and material fees collected from attendees will be paid to the teacher in full. We do not collect a commission or percentage. In addition, the committee provides a stipend for one night of lodging for each class you teach with more than 5 students to offset your travel expenses. The stipend is at the average double occupancy rate – approximately \$50/night. This credit will be applied to your bill when you register for JQS. Teachers will need to plan to cover their meals.
