Sheep will be sold in uniform lots sorted according to producers. Sheep will become the property of the purchaser immediately after the sale. No sheep will be loaded until the conclusion of the sale. All fees will be collected after the sale. **No further sales or trades can be made on site after the sale closes.**

TRANSPORTATION

If you purchase 10 head or more, you have the option of free transportation within a 100-mile radius of London, KY. The Southeast Kentucky Sheep Producers Association reserves the right to transport the sheep by the most economical means possible. Arrangements can be made with private haulers to transport the sheep for a buyer who purchases less than 10 sheep for a negotiated price. The Southeast Kentucky Sheep Producers Association assumes no liability in transportation. All sheep must be off premises the day of the sale.

Health papers will be provided upon request for sheep being transported out of state.

REGISTERED / PUREBRED INFORMATION

She opened Southeast Eyecare, P.S.C. in 2007 and makes and sells prescription eye wear and contact lenses. Ron is the miller at McHargue's Mill and Director of the Mountain Life Museum at Levi Jackson Park. Lisa learned to spin in 1996 and loves making yarn. She spins the wool from her sheep by hand and then knits or crochets it into hats, mittens, fingerless gloves, stockings and more. Ron uses the handspun wool yarn to weave shawls on a triangular peg loom. Ron and Lisa love to participate in reenactments of the 1760-1800 time periods. Lisa also sells the freshly shorn fleeces from her sheep to anyone wanting to work with wool. Ron and Lisa were originally introduced to the Shetland breed in 2000. Rose Gate Farm was purchased and established in the fall of 2009. Ron and Lisa chose the Shetland breed of sheep for the hardiness and ease of maintaining. They choose to raise their sheep as organic as possible. The multipurpose uses of the Shetlands and their size were also factors in their decision. Fully grown ewes range from 60-90 lbs. and rams 90-120 lbs. They lamb easily without help and have anywhere from 1-3 lambs at a time. Their wool is wonderful to the touch. Their meat is mild and not considered mutton until they are over the age of 2 years according to the Shetland Sheep Society website. Shetlands can also be milked if one desires.
